Read these as starting points, not green lights.

Most "100 ideas" lists are a model's confident guesses. This one is built the opposite way. Every idea here starts from a real outside signal, a funded company, a partner thesis from YC or a16z, a shipping product, or a real complaint we could quote, and then asks what a solo builder could ship next to it. The source is printed on the card so you can check it yourself.

Read each card as a starting point, not a green light. We tag the demand honestly as real, thin, or speculative, we name who already plays in the space, and we say what we could not verify. None of these are promised to work.

How to find the real no before you build

- 1** Talk to ten real people who have the problem. Not friends, not the model.
- 2** Put up a fake door or a landing page and watch what people actually do.
- 3** Look for money or commitment, a deposit, a pre-order, a card on a waitlist, not enthusiasm.
- 4** Make the AI argue against the idea first. Ask for the bear case and the real threads, not the pitch.
- 5** Use AI to build the thing, not to decide whether it should exist.

01 A scheduled voice agent that calls your aging parent every week, asks a few questions that build on last week's...

SIGNAL Space receipt is the a16z "See Me" lane plus a crowded, money-making category that proves people pay for this: StoryWorth...

WEDGE You are not selling the interview, that is a race to the bottom now.

CATCH This is the bear-case result, and it is the strongest part.
